


or he himself [jesus christ] is our peace, who has made both [jew and gentile] one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in his flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that he might reconcile them both to god in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

Now, therefore, you are no longer Strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, jesus christ himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the spirit.

herefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as new-born babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the lord is gracious, coming to him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by god and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to god through jesus christ.

Therefore, to you who believe, he is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "the stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone," and "a stone of stumbling and a rock of offence." but you who once were not a people are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

mo the disciples eame and said to him, "why do you speak to them in parables?" Then he will also say to those on the left hand, depart from me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: for I was hungry and you gave me no food; I was thirsty and you gave me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take me in, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.

Then they also will answer him, saying, lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to you? Then he will answer them, saying, 'assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.' And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."



hen he [jesus] said, "What is the kingdom of God Like? And to What shall I compare it? knows what the mind of the spirit is, because he makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God. And we know that all things work together for Good to those who love god, to those who are the called according to his purpose.

For whom he foreknew, he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he predestined, these he also called; whom he called, these he also justified; and whom he justified, these he also glorified.

Things? If God is for us, who ean be against us? He who did not spare his own son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

The shall bring a charge against goo's elect? It is goo who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of goo, who also makes intercession for us.

ho shall separate us from the love of christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakeoness, or peril, or sworo? As it is written: "for your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

TOR I AM PERSUADED THAT NEITHER DEATH NOR LIFE, NOR ANGELS NOR PRINCIPALITIES NOR POWERS, NOR THINGS PRESENT NOR THINGS TO COME, NOR HEIGHT NOR DEPTH, NOR ANY OTHER CREATED THING, SHALL BE ABLE TO SEPARATE US FROM THE LOVE OF GOD Which is in christ jesus our lord.

or no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is jesus christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the day will beclare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is.

on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the spirit of God dwells in you?

F Anyone defiles the temple of God, God Will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are. Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise.

For the Wisdom of this world is poolishness with God. for it is written, "he eatches the Wise in their own eraftiness"; and again, "the lord knows the thoughts of the Wise, that they are futile." Therefore let no one boast in men.

or since by man [adam] came death, by man [jesus] also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in adam all die, even so in christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order: christ the first-fruits, afterward those who are christ's at his coming. Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to god the father, when he puts an end to all rule and all authority and power.

FOR he must reign till he has put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. For "he has put all things under his feet."

no the scripture, foreseeing that good would justify the gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to abraham beforehand, saying, "in you all the nations shall be blessed." so then those who are of faith are blessed with believing abraham.

The LAW ARE UNDER THE WORKS OF THE LAW ARE UNDER THE CURSE; FOR IT IS WRITTEN, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO DOES NOT CONTINUE IN ALL THINGS WHICH ARE WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE LAW, TO DO THEM." BUT THAT NO ONE IS JUSTIFIED BY THE LAW IN THE SIGHT OF GOD IS EVIDENT, FOR "THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH." YET THE LAW IS NOT OF FAITH, BUT "THE MAN WHO DOES THEM SHALL LIVE BY THEM."

thrist has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of abraham might come upon the centiles in christ lesus, that we might receive the promise of the spirit through faith.

The promises made. He does not say, "and to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "and to your seed," who is christ. And this I say, that the law, which was four hundred and thirty years later, cannot annul the covenant that was confirmed before by god in christ, that it should make the promise of no effect. For if the inheritance is of the law, it is no longer of promise; but god gave it to abraham by promise.

hat purpose then does the law serve? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed [christ] should come to whom the promise was made; and it was appointed through angels by the hand of a mediator. Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! for if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness would have been by the law.

under sin, that the promise by faith in jesus christ might be given to those who believe but before faith eame, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed. Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to christ, that we might be justified by faith.

of this reason i, paul, the prisoner of thrist jesus for you centiles—if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of god which was given to me for you, how that by revelation he made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already, by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of christ), which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the spirit to his holy apostles and prophets:

That the centiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of his promise in christ through the gospel, of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of god given to me by the effective working of his power.

of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the centiles the unsearchable riches of christ, and to make all see what 15 the fellowship of the mystery, Which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created All things through jesus christ; to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known By the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, according to the eternal purpose which he accomplished in christ jesus our lord, in whom we have boloness and access with confidence through FAITH IN him.

e has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the son of his love, in whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins.

The christ is the image of the invisible god, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things consist.

no he is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things he may have the pre-eminence. For it pleased the father that in him all the fullness should dwell, and by him to reconcile all things to himself, by him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of his cross.

And enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now he has reconciled in the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in his sight—if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadpast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.

Through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to thrist. For in him dwells all the fullness of the godhead bodily; and you are complete in him, who is the head of all principality and power.



Lessed be the God and father of our lord jesus christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in christ, just as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by jesus christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, to the praise of the glory of his grace, by which he has made us accepted in the beloved.

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace which he made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he purposed in himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times he might gather together in one all things in christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in him.

In him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, that we who first trusted in christ should be to the praise of his glory.

no he put all things under his feet, and gave him to be head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.

no you he made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the Air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.



out god, who is rich in mercy, because Dof his great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in TRESPASSES, MADE US Alive Together WITH CHRIST (BY GRACE YOU have been SAVED), AND RAISED US UP TOGETHER. and made us sit together in the heavenly places in christ jesus, that in the ages to come he might show The exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us in christ jesus. For By grace you have been saved Through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. for through him we both have access by one spirit to the father now, therefore, you are no longer STRANGERS AND FOREIGNERS, BUT FELLOW citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, jesus christ himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the lord,

E thank god without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe for you, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God which are in judga in christ jesus. For you also suffered the same things from your own countrymen, just as they old from the judeans, who killed both the lord jesus and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they do not please god and are contrary to all men, forbidding us to speak to the centiles that they may be saved, so AS ALWAYS TO FILL UP THE MEASURE OF Their sins; but wrath has come upon Them to the uttermost.

FOR What is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? is it not even you in the presence of our lord jesus christ at his coming? for you are our glory and joy.

or this we say to you by the word of the lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.

FROM heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the lord in the Air. And thus we shall always be with the lord. Therefore comport one another with these words.

But concerning the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you for you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labour pains upon a pregnant woman and they shall not escape.

ow the spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron,

Things, you will be a good minister of jesus christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed. But reject profane and old wives fables, and exercise yourself toward gooliness.

But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: for men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of god, always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.



pirstborn [christ] into the world, he says: "Let all the angels of god worship him." And of the angels he says: "Who makes his angels spirits and his ministers a flame of fire." But to the son he says: "Your throne, o god, is forever and ever; a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore god, your god, has anointed you with the oil of gladness more than your companions."
