Thus says God the LORD, who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, who gives breath to the people on it, and spirit to those who walk on it;

“I, the LORD, have called You in righteousness, and will hold Your hand; I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, as a light to the Gentiles, to bring out prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness from the prison house.

I AM the LORD, that is My name; and My glory I will not give to another, nor My praise to carved images.

Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.”

These two volumes are intended to represent God the LORD, and to not be about ‘mankind’. Texts from The Scriptures have been chosen to reveal aspects of His character embodied in His holy name.

The integrity, unity and totality of the Holy Bible is apparent when these volumes are considered as parallel companions; Old Testament inspirations and prophecies become fulfilled or explained in New Testament revelations – any given page in volume 1 (OT) connects to the same page in volume 2 (NT).



Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, *when* I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you.’ And they say to me, ‘What *is* His name?’ what shall I say to them?”

And God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’ ”

Moreover God said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel; ‘The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This *is* My name forever, and this *is* My memorial to all generations.’ ”

Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them, ‘The LORD God your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared to me, saying, “I have surely visited you and *seen* what is done to you in Egypt; and I have said I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt to the land of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, to a land flowing with milk and honey.’ ”

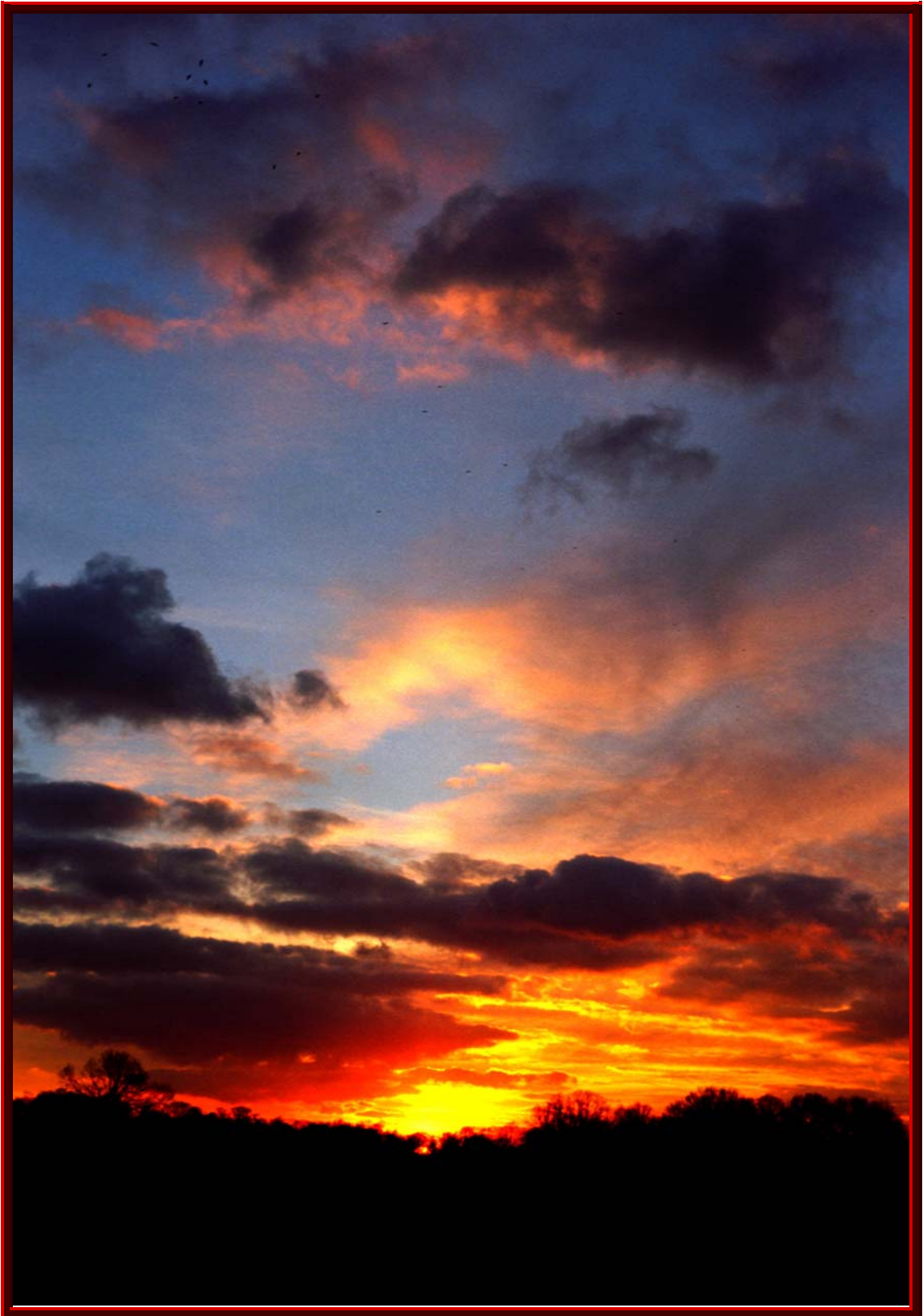
GENESIS 1: VERSES 1 – 5

I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness in the great assembly; indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O LORD, You Yourself know.

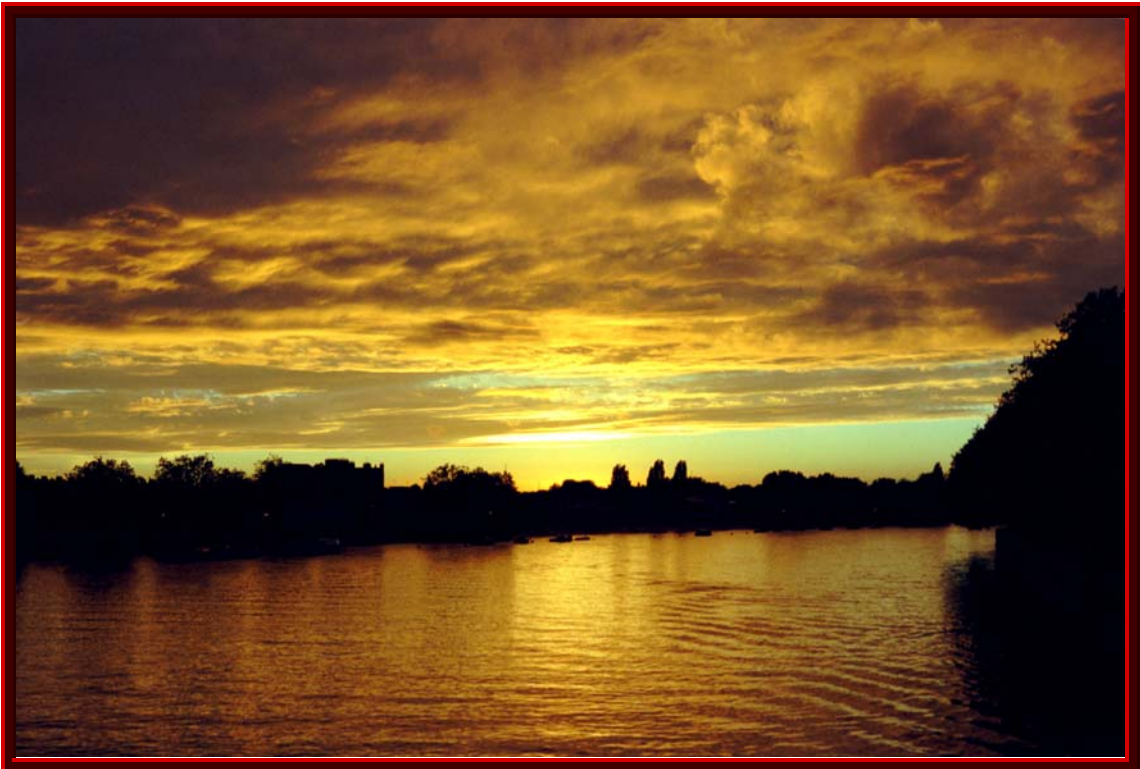

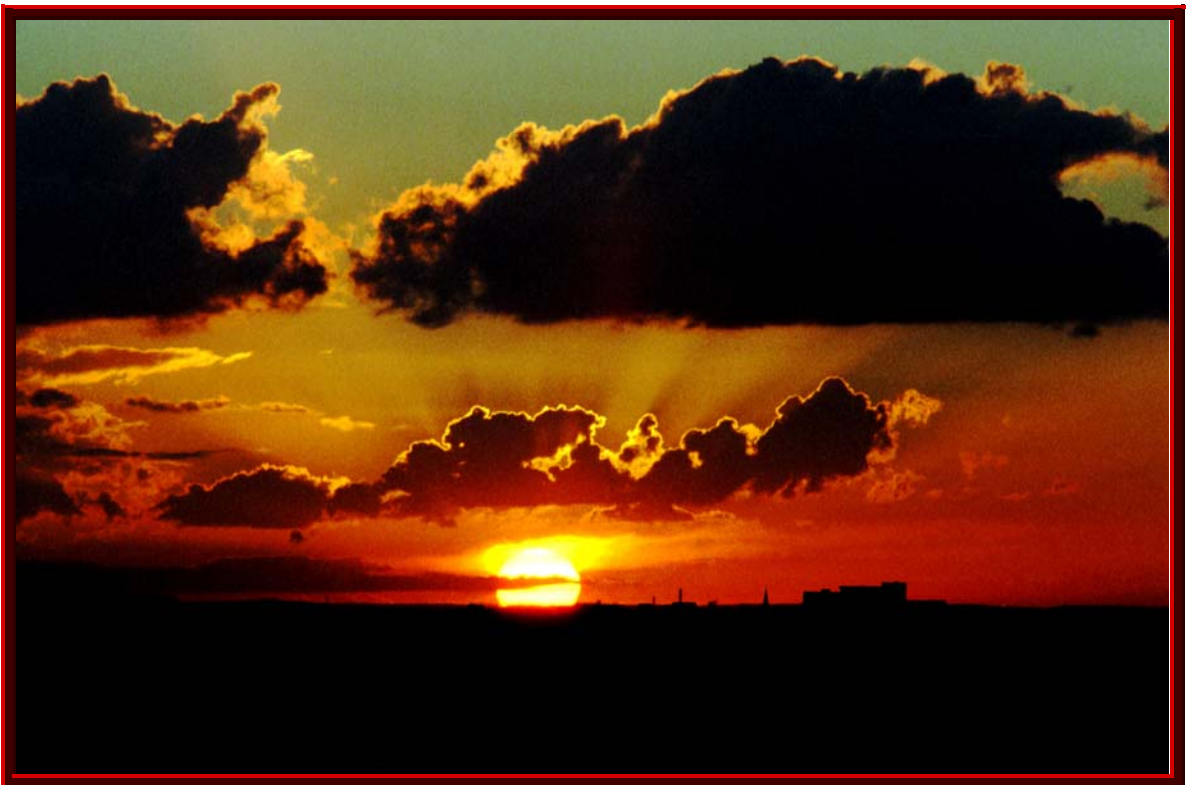

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

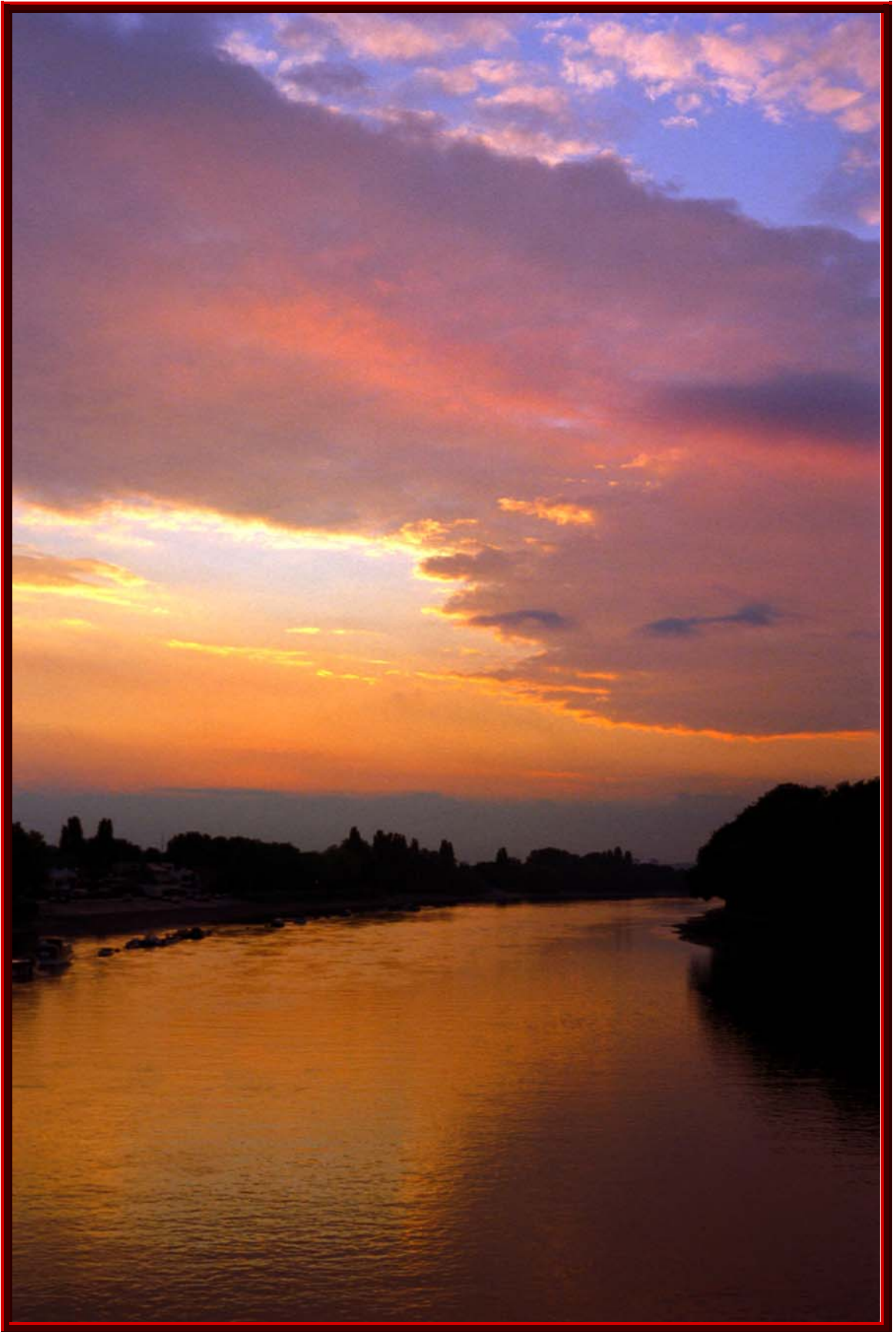
ISAIAH 53: 4 – 6

Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in.

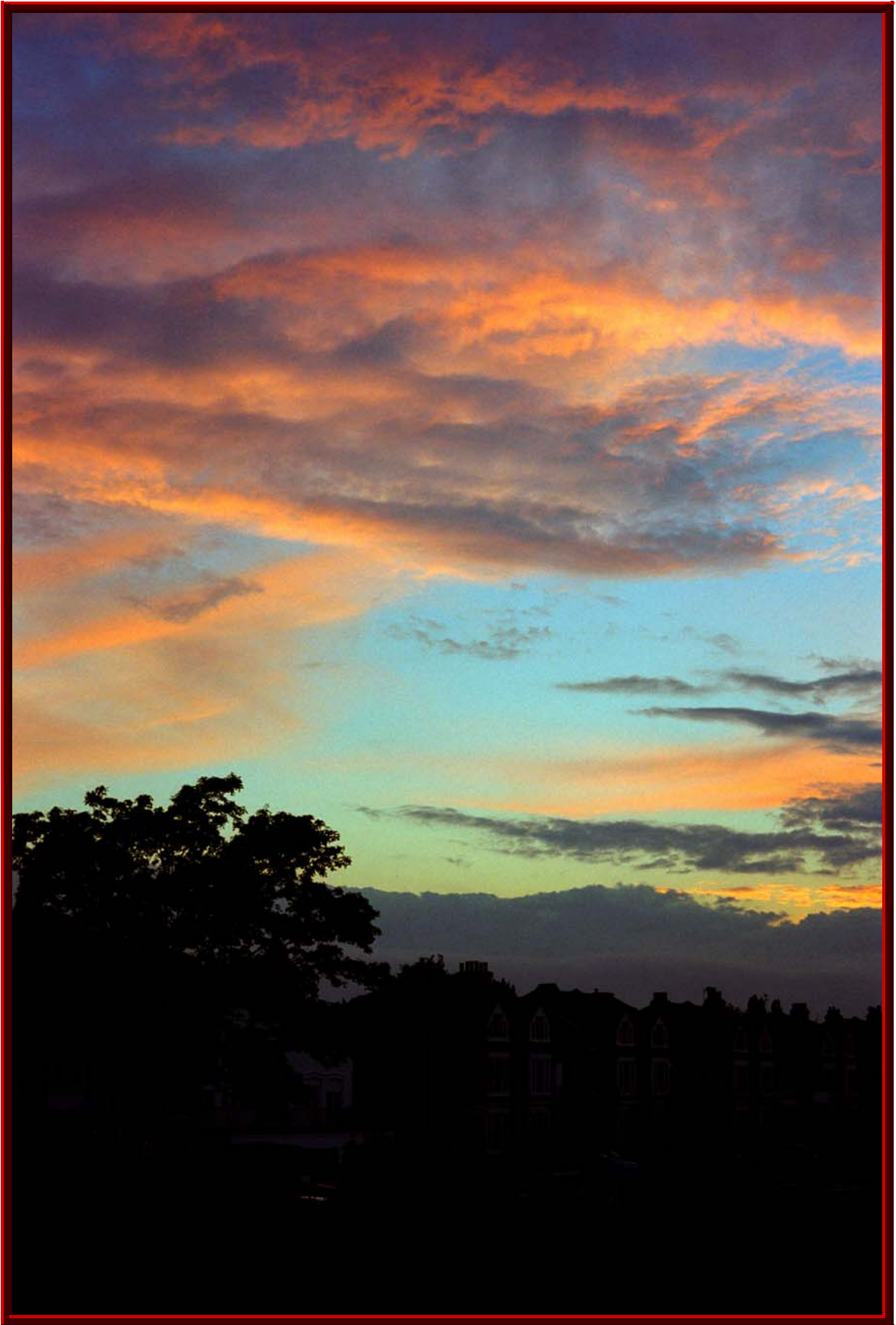
Who *is* this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.

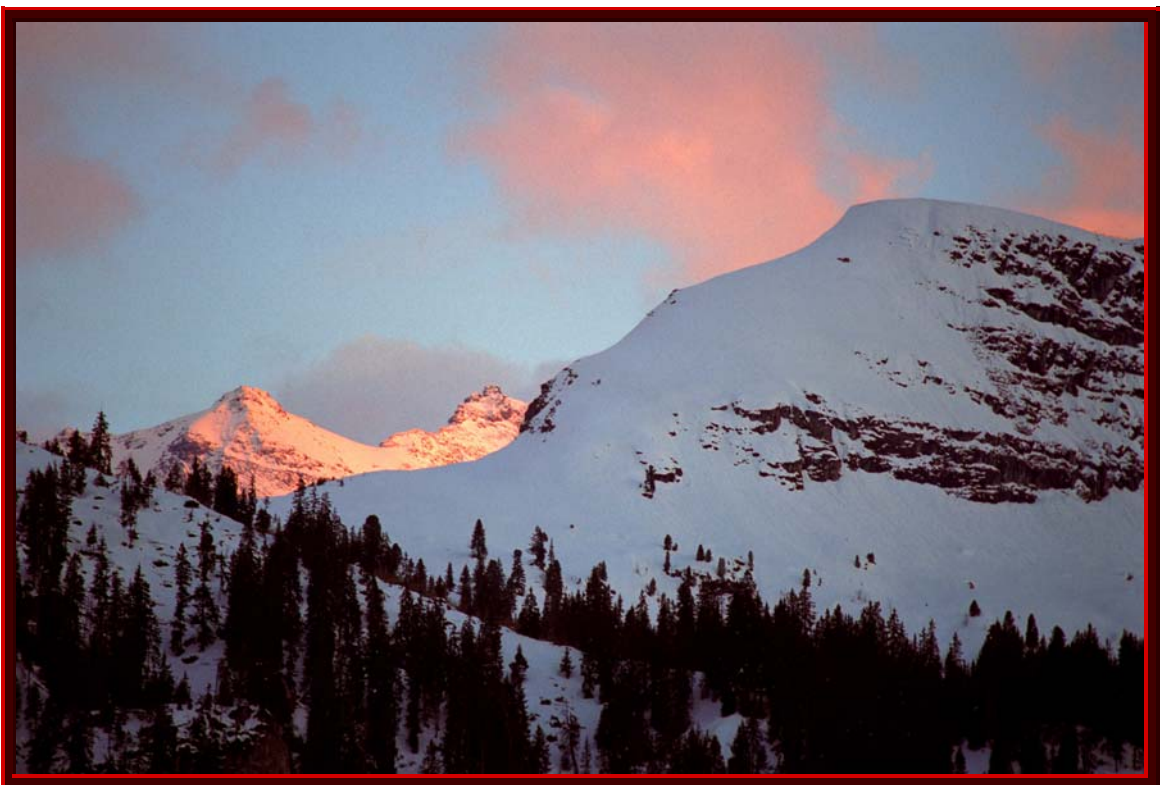

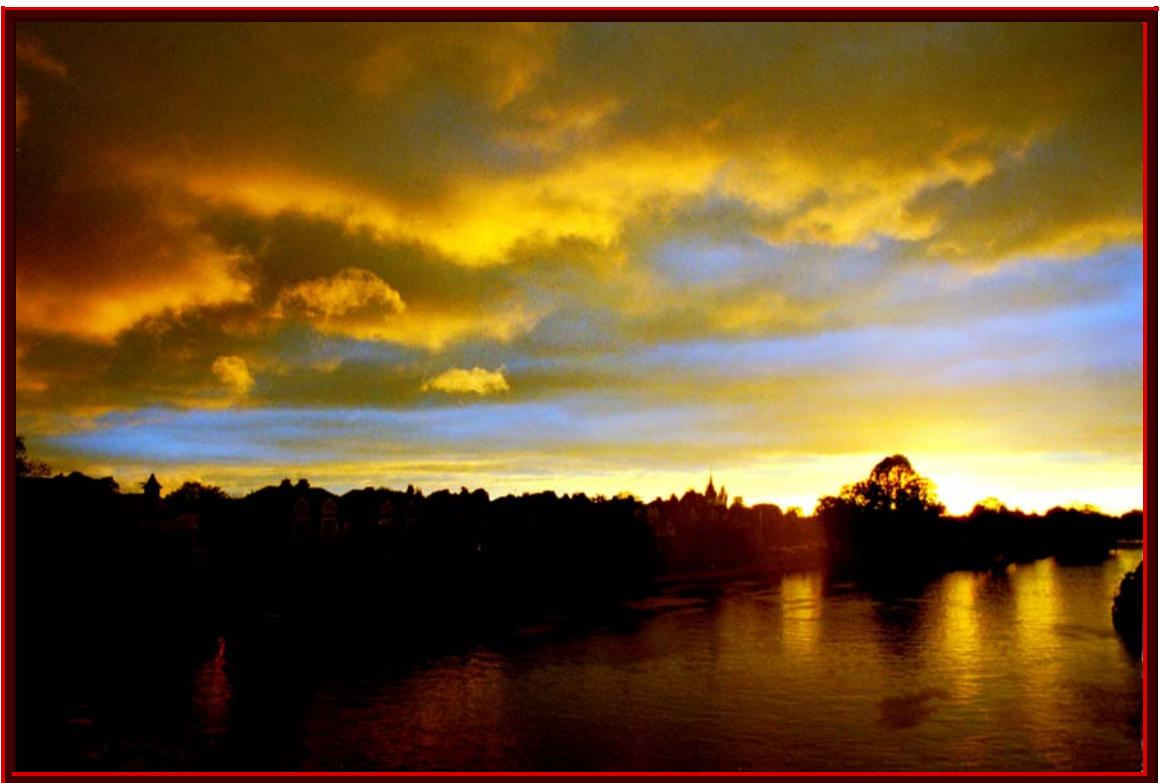

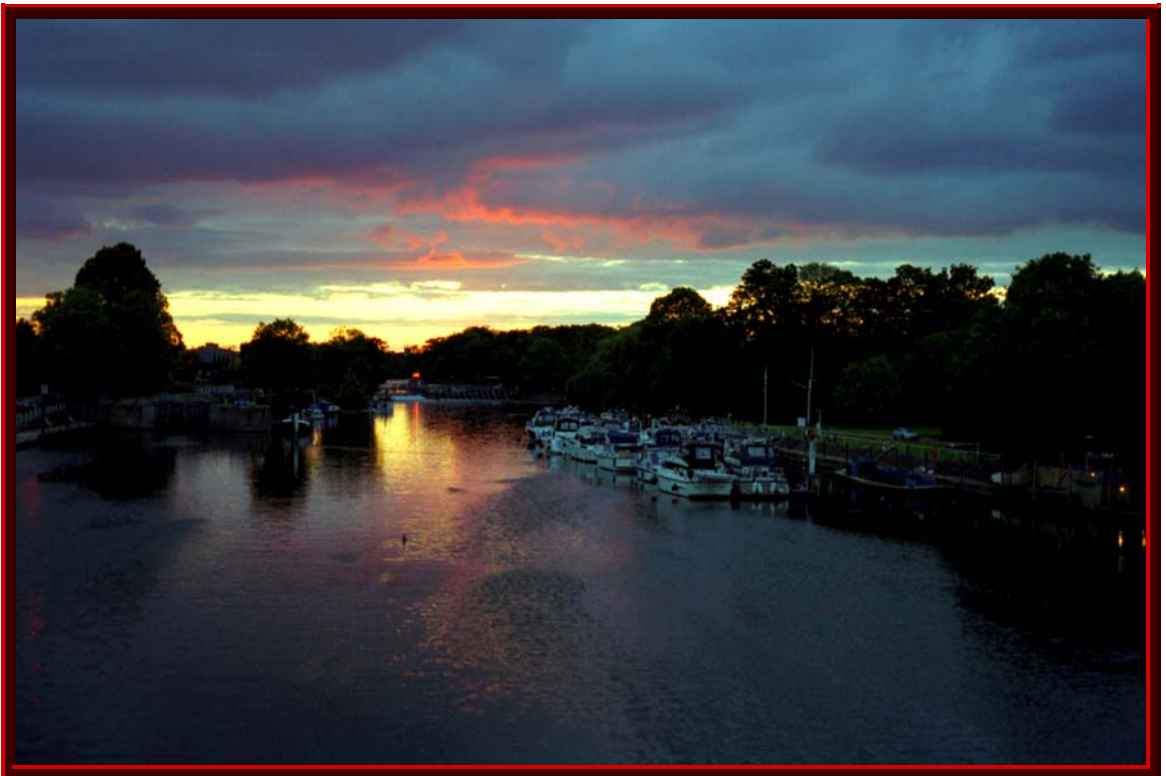
